

What to include in your Proposal

1. Proposal Summary (200–300 words)

Your summary should give us a clear idea of your contribution. Please include:

- The central idea or argument of your proposed piece.
- Why this topic matters now, especially in light of current political, social, or cultural struggles.
- How it relates to European Alternatives' focus on democracy, equality, and transnational resistance.
- The format you envision: essay, poem, testimony, interview, fiction, visual story, photo series etc.

2. Proposed Structure

Offer a short outline of the article structure.

- This can be 3 to 5 bullet points or a short paragraph summary.
- This should include an estimated word count (typical submissions range from 1,500–3,000 words, longer if justified).

3. Contributor Information

- Full name and contact details.
- Short bio (50–100 words).
- Any links to previous relevant work or portfolio.

4. Additional Details (if applicable)

- Potential collaborators, contributors or interviewees.
- Any rights or permissions required for re-using existing material.
- Preferred timeline for completing the piece.
