


Deliverable D5.2 - Repository of knowledge resources

The Democratic Odyssey's digital platform provides a single space where Assembly Members, observers, analysts, and the general public, can reach the archival of all the material related to the Assembly and familiarise with the process. This is all digitalised and uploaded on the digital platform, so that it can be consulted in multiple languages and be as accessible as possible, also with a smartphone throughout the Assembly process.
