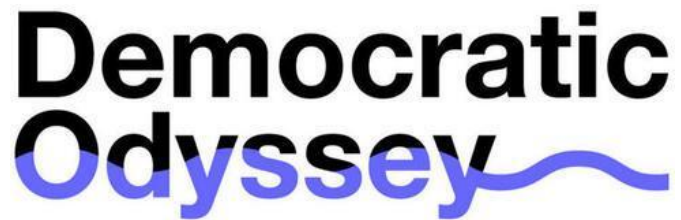

Civil Society Engagement in the Democratic Odyssey

In many models of deliberative democracy, civil society organisations (CSOs) are excluded from participation based on concerns about neutrality or fears that organised actors might introduce bias and disrupt the 'purity' of citizen input. But this perspective misses the point. It overlooks the structural inequalities that shape who gets to speak, who feels confident to participate, and whose knowledge is seen as legitimate. CSOs are often the ones working most closely with communities who are deeply affected by political decisions yet rarely invited into political spaces.
